

2025 SUMMER CAMP INFORMATION



Thank you for your interest in YaYa's Performance Academy's summer camps. **Below you will find the detailed information about our camp weeks:**

- Online Enrollment Every performer must set up an account through our online enrollment system (Studio Pro or SP) that can be accessed from our website www.yayasacademy.com by clicking on the PAYMENT button on any page or the ENROLL button on the show specific page. Once your family account is set up with emergency contact information and contact info. it will be saved for future programs. You may make your payments online using paypal, a credit card, or a debit card. The only way to save your spot in one of our summer programs is by enrolling and paying in full online. Your spot will not be saved until full payment is received. We will only accept walk-in enrollment the day that a program starts if there is space available. Space is limited! Minimum 10 enrolled to keep it open.
- **Refund policy** We will only issue refunds or credit your account if requested at least 2 weeks prior to the start date of the camp.
- Participation Waivers: Agreement to all waivers are required to participate in any programs. You can view and agree to the waivers once you set up an online enrollment account on Studio Pro by clicking the enroll button on the website. All returning participants will need to read the updated policies on SP and click on the box to submit agreement. See instructions for how to access waivers on our website.

- o Summer camps run <u>Monday through Friday 9 am- 12 pm</u> each week. <u>Camp rehearsals will be closed to parents.</u>

What to expect?

o Campers will learn songs and dances from the Musical theme for the week. They will have the opportunity to audition for a solo or speaking role on Tuesday of each week.

We will teach them what they need to perform for the solo & speaking role auditions. All campers will have the opportunity to work on scenes and songs from the theme.

What to bring to camp?

- Please send campers to rehearsals with a water bottle and a snack. We will take a short break halfway through the session to have a snack. Please let us know if your child has any allergies.
- Campers will receive some materials such as lyric sheets, scene pages, etc. Please be sure that they bring it with them every day along with a pencil. A simple pocket folder will be helpful to hold all their papers.
- They can wear comfortable clothes that they can dance in and closed toed shoes they can dance in like sneakers or jazz shoes if they have them.
- Performance- On the final day of camp, we will do an in-person performance for parents the last 15 minutes of class. We ask that you limit the number of people attending to 2. We just don't have the space for Grandma and Grandpa and extra friends to come watch. We appreciate your cooperation!
- BAND APP-We are using the Band app to communicate all program information including schedules, dance videos, music tracks, hand-outs, reminders, etc. Please click on the link below to be added to our "Band." You will be prompted to download the app on your phone or other device and then I will approve you as a member once you answer the privacy question.
 - Please have your older kids with phones or an iPad download the app as well, this way they will have access to rehearsal materials without always having to use your phone. The Band app is for ages 13 and older.
 - You can contact us directly through the chat function in the app. We will be using this one "band" for all our summer programs. We will have specific folders for each class/camp with the rehearsal materials they will need to practice with at home. Please keep in mind that most of the time info will be sent out in a group chat. If you want to respond or ask a question that only pertains to your performer, please private message YaYa instead of responding on the group chat.
 - When your class is done you can remove yourself as a member or remain a member to keep receiving the general YaYa's summer reminders and notifications. Band is also accessible from your computer by going to www.band.us and logging in with the same username and password you used on the app on your phone.
